Dilip Kumar

Muhammad Yusuf Khan, known professionally as Dillip Kumar, a fine actor. Popularly known as The Tragedy King and The First Khan, he has been credited with bringing realism to film acting since his first film and is regarded as one of the greatest actors of world cinema.



Madhubala

Madhubala, original name Mumtaz Jehan Begum Dehlavi was the most celebrated female Bollywood star during the 1950s and '60s. She was especially famed for her beauty, so much so that her accomplished acting was often overlooked.



Dev Anand

Madhubala, original name Mumtaz Jehan Begum Dehlavi was Arguably the most beautiful artiste to ever grace the Indian screen, Madhubala rose from humble beginnings to become the most captivating star India has ever produced.



Hema Malini

Hema Malini (born 16 October 1948) is an actress, writer, director, producer, dancer and politician. Malini was initially promoted as the "Dream Girl", and in 1977 starred in a film of the same name. She has played both comic and dramatic roles, as well as being a dancer.



Meena Kumari

Actress, singer and poet under the pseudonym Naaz, who starred in classic films of Hindi Cinema. Popularly known as The Tragedy Queen, Chinese Doll and Female Guru Dutt, she is often remembered as Cinderella of Indian films.



Raj Kapoor

Actor, producer and director of Indian cinema known for his big banner RK Films. Born at Kapoor Haveli in Peshawar to actor Prithviraj Kapoor— he was a member of the Kapoor family which produced several Bollywood superstars.



Mumtaz

A British-Indian film actress. She won a Filmfare Award for Best Actress for her character in Khilona in 1971. Though she started with small supporting roles, she later rose up the hierarchy, and worked with all the top actors of her time, in the lead roles.



Rajesh Khanna

Actor, film producer and politician who is best known for his work in the Hindi cinema. He is referred to as the "First Superstar" of Indian cinema. He starred in 15 consecutive solo hit films from 1969 to 1971, a record 'unbroken' as of 2019.

Yesteryears' Stars



Shashi Kapoor

Actor and film producer and recipient of several accolades, including four National Film Awards and two Filmfare Awards, Kapoor predominantly worked in Hindi films. He also featured in a number of English-language films produced by Merchant-Ivory.



Nargis

Nargis Dutt starred in classic films starting as a child artist. From the carefree laughter of a mischievous runaway girl in 'Chori Chori', to the stoic stance of a suffering Radha in 'Mother India', film actress Nargis still reign our hearts.



Vinod Khanna

Actor, film producer and active politician when he was MP. He was the recipient of two Filmfare awards. He appeared in 137 films, of which 54 are solo hero films and 47 are two-hero films with he as the lead hero.



Sri Devi

Actress and producer, who worked in Tamil, Hindi, Telugu, Malayalam and Kannada films. Sridevi was voted 'India's Greatest Actress in 100 Years' in a CNN-IBN national poll conducted in 2013 on the occasion of the centenary of Indian cinema.

Also known by her married name Aishwarya Rai Bachchan, is an Indian actress, model and the winner of the Miss World 1994 pageant. Through her successful acting career, she has established herself as one of the most popular and influential celebrities in India.



Aamir Khan

Actor, director, filmmaker and television talk-show host. Through his career spanning over thirty years in Hindi films, he is established as one of the most dedicated actors in this world. With his recent success in India and China markets combined he has got the title of World's Biggest Superstar.



Deepika Padukone

The highest-paid actress in India, her accolades include three Filmfare Awards. She features in listings of the nation's most popular personalities, and Time named her one of the 100 most influential people in the world in 2018.



Akshay Kumar

From a waiter in Bangkok, to the most successful actor in Bollywood, Indian-born Canadian actor, producer & television personality who is a black belt in martial arts is always the first choice to do adventurous movies as he does his own stunts. He is a Padma Shri award in the year 2009, one of India's highest civilian awards.

Kareena was born to Sindhi-speaking Babita (nee Shivdasani) and Punjabi-speaking Randhir Kapoor into a family that has been actors for generations. She is one of the most sought-after actresses in Bollywood, considered bankable, with an enviable A-listing.



Ranveer Singh

Ranveer Singh had always wanted to be an actor since his childhood. Now the recipient of several awards, including three Filmfare Awards, Singh is among the highest-paid actors in the country and has featured in Forbes India's Celebrity 100 list since 2012.



Katrina Kaif

Katrina Kaif is an English actress. Despite receiving mixed reviews from critics for her acting prowess, she has established herself in Bollywood and is one of India's highest-paid actresses. Born in Hong Kong, Kaif and her family lived around the world before she moved to London.



Saif Ali Khan

Film actor and producer, son of actress Sharmila Tagore and cricketer Mansoor Ali Khan Pataudi, he has received several awards as well as numerous nominations. He continues to not only act in movies but has also started his very own production company 'Illuminati Films'.



Priyanka Chopra

Priyanka Chopra Jonas is an Indian actress, singer, film producer, and the winner of the Miss World 2000 pageant. One of India's highest-paid and most popular celebrities, Chopra has received numerous awards, including one National Film Awards and five Filmfare Awards.



Shahrukh Khan

Also known by the initialism SRK, is an Indian actor, film producer, and television personality. Referred to in the media as the "Badshah of Bollywood", "King of Bollywood" and "King Khan", he has appeared in more than 80 Bollywood films, and earned numerous accolades, including 14 Filmfare Awards.



Sonam Kapoor

Sonam Kapoor comes from an established film family and has received a National Film Award and a Filmfare Award, and from 2012–2016, she appeared in Forbes India's Celebrity 100 list based on her income and popularity.



Hrithik Roshan

A leading actor he is known globally for his versatile roles, unmatched dancing skills and attractive looks. After having appeared in films as a child actor in the 80s he grew in his acting to now often described as "India's Most Complete Actor". About the Young Executives Group

The YOUNG EXECUTIVES GROUP, popularly known as "Y.E.G." was formed in 1964 by two leading Indian businessmen of Hong Kong, Mr. K. Sital and Mr. Bob Harilela. In 1984 they decided to create separate Hong Kong and Kowloon chapters. Mr. K. Sital took the initiative and responsibility in establishing the Hong Kong chapter. He invited a group of 20 Indians for lunch at the Thailand Room of the old Hilton Hotel and 18 of those attending became the nucleus from which the HK YEG was formed.

Mr. Lai Malani, was elected the 1st President of the Group. Thereafter, a succession of leading members of the community took over the mantle of the Presidency and helped build the Group into what it has become today comprising of over 150 members from a cross-section of the Indian community. The membership ranks of Y.E.G. HK comprises of an interesting array of distinctive, dynamic and enterprising group of individuals from the Indian community. The secret of the Group's success has been its ability to attract and keep as members a combination

of fathers/sons, uncles/ nephews as well as fathers/sons-in-law all within the umbrella of one group running across the age range of 27-85 years. It is this diversity in unity that has been the catalyst that has allowed the Group to grow from strength to strength over the last 50 years.

Y.E.G. HK meets on the first Tuesday of every month, except in the month of August. This year, the meetings have been held at the Grand Hyatt Hotel, with a different theme for each menu.

The members are entertained by interesting speakers who touch on such diverse subjects as finance, business, health, real estate, stock market as well as talks on spirituality. Apart from providing a social luncheon platform for members, the Group also provides a forum for dissemination of ideas and exchange of information and knowledge over a wide spectrum of topics.
